



Heat 3 – Cherub State Championship

NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

1. On arrival at the club everyone will be asked to park on the grass adjacent to the Flag mast and ramp leading down to the beach. There will be a parking marshal present so if you can follow his directions we should have no problems.
Please note parking on a Sunday can be a little chaotic so the earlier you arrive the easier it will be.
2. There is a Coffee shop – the KTB - downstairs near to the ramp leading to the beach that is open from 6.30am and also brunch is available upstairs from 10.30am
3. Unfortunately we are subject to all sorts of “rules” relating to the dreaded Covid-19, so here is a summary of the things we ask all visitors to follow while you are at the club.
 - a) On arrival if you can proceed to the race office which is downstairs on the eastern end of the Club (the opposite side of the building to the KTB) and register that you are at the Club, this applies to all visitors including parents, spectators and competitors. Adults only, any adults with children/youth under the age of 18 also need to indicate the number of children under their supervision.
 - b) Unfortunately we are unable to allow the use of our showers at the moment, our changing rooms are available however there is a limit of 8 people at any one time.
 - c) We have to be careful about the normal social distancing rules so at any time that you are inside the sailing rooms if you can avoid congregating in groups, coming in only to do what you need to do and then returning to the beach or rigging areas.
 - d) Everyone is more than welcome to go upstairs to the licenced club at any time morning or evening, you just need to follow the normal sign in procedures and dress regulations.
4. In addition to registering your presence at the Club for Covid-19 competitors also need to sign on and sign off their intention to race, this is mandatory and is an on-water safety matter, this is an entirely separate document to the Covid19 register.
5. So to the actual sailing – weather permitting it is our intention to sail on the bay, so competitors should allow 20-30 minutes to get out to the starting line; additional information to the sailing instructions:
 - a) Start and Finish mark will be a green inflatable cylinder with an orange band.
 - b) Rounding marks will be pink inflatable cylinders.
