RACE FORMAT

3 races held over the weekend consisting of two short races (target time 45 min) and one long race (target time 90 min)

COURSE FORMAT

For this round only, racing will be on a windward / leeward style course shared with the 13ft & 16ft skiff fleets using a shared bottom gate and separate top marks.

Each fleet will have separate starts, with the order to be determined on the day by class flags on the start boat.

The number of laps for each race will be indicated by a numeral pennant flag on the start boat.

Mark 1 will be a yellow inflatable cylinder - 16ft skiffs

Mark 1A will be a yellow inflatable cylinder with a red cherub heart - 13ft skiffs & cherubs

Marks 2A and 2B will be yellow inflatable cylinders - 16ft skiffs, 13ft skiffs & cherubs

The Start Mark will be an orange inflatable cylinder

The Finish Mark will be a black and white checked inflatable cylinder
